Day to Day Itinerary

Feb 12 - 13: Overnight Flight to Buenos Aires

Depart Minneapolis and enjoy an overnight flight to beautiful Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Feb 13 - 14: Buenos Aires, Argentina

After an overnight flight, welcome to Argentina! Arrive in Buenos Aires in the early morning and transfer to your hotel with time to rest and explore on your own. Founded in the early 16th century, Buenos Aires is known as the "Paris of the South". One of the pleasures of this cosmopolitan city is simply absorbing its charm and flavor from Parisian-style cafés to popular tango clubs. Enjoy a romantic walk through one of the city's many pristine parks or along its wide boulevards.

Feb 14: Buenos Aires, Argentina

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before joining a local guide for a tour of the scintillating capital of Argentina on a half-day city tour. Visit La Boca to take a stroll along the main street, drive through Plaza de Mayo and visit Recoleta Cemetery. Take in views of El Centro and the famed Tres de Febrero Park—the largest of Buenos Aires' 150 parks—before transferring to your home for the next 14 days on the luxurious *Celebrity Equinox*.
Ship sets sail at 5:00 pm.

Feb 15: Montevideo, Uruguay

8:00 am - 5:00 pm

A charming city made up of 19th century Beaux Arts buildings, parks and historic monuments, Montevideo is home to more than half of the nation's three million citizens. Located at Uruguay's southernmost point on the Rio de la Plata, you will visit the picturesque streets of Colonia del Sacramento, the oldest city in Uruguay and recently declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You may wish to take a guided tour of Uruguay's wine region.

Feb 16 - 17: At Sea

While at sea, take the time to recharge before your next adventure. Lounge by the pool, be spoiled at the spa, taste the delicacies or explore the venues on-board.

Feb 18: Falkland Islands (Stanley)

8:00 am - 6:00 pm

Stanley Harbor is dotted with the hulks of vessels that succumbed to the fierce winds and waves of the South Atlantic. While their strategic location led to important roles in both World Wars, the islands are best remembered as the cause of the 1982 war between Argentina and the United Kingdom. Today, travelers increasingly journey to the islands to view their rich assortment of bird and marine life. Don't miss one of the many Penguin Colony tours offered.

Feb 19: At Sea

Feb 20: Cape Horn Scenic Cruising

Tierra del Fuego, or "Land of Fire" is the most remote place in the Americas, with Cape Horn marking its southernmost point. Known for its dramatic cliffs and windswept shores, this rugged landscape is where the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans collide. Spend the day crossing the Cape Horn and it's splendid views for a breathtaking journey.

Feb 21: Ushuaia, Argentina

8:00 am - 6:00 pm

A former whaling station and Argentine penal colony, Ushuaia serves as your gateway to the wilderness where snow-capped mountains plummet to the icy waters of the Beagle Channel. Don't miss Tierra del Fuego National Park. This protected land includes the beautiful Lakes of Fagnano and Roca, the Beagle Channel and the southernmost sub-Antarctic forests.

Feb 22: Strait of Magellan Scenic Cruising

Embark on a once-in-a-lifetime adventure through the legendary Strait of Magellan, a 350-mile passage that ranks high on every cruiser's bucket list. As you sail, you'll be captivated by the vast Tierra del Fuego plains, the majestic Amalia Glacier, the pristine Seno Eyre Fjord and the vibrant wildlife that calls this region home. Be on the lookout for humpback whales, colonies of Magellan penguins and so much more.

Feb 23: Punta Arenas, Chile

7:00 am - 3:00 pm

Enjoy the southernmost city on Earth overlooking the Strait of Magellan. The best spot to gain an introduction to Punta Arenas is the Cerro La Cruz promontory, which provides breathtaking views of the city's orderly streets, colorful tin roofs and the strait beyond. Among the city's most interesting attractions are the Museo Salesiano de Mayonino Borgatello, started by an order of Italian missionaries and the Centro Cultural Braun-Menéndez, housed in the mansion of one of the city's most prosperous families. From Punta Arenas, it is an easy day trip to the Pinguineros, the nearby penguin settlements and the Parque Nacional Torres del Paine, which provides the perfect introduction to Chilean Antarctica.

Feb 24: At Sea

Feb 25: Puerto Madryn, Argentina

9:00 am - 5:30 pm

Founded in 1865 by Welsh immigrants, Puerto Madryn is your gateway to Patagonia's natural wonders. From this deep-water port, explore the Valdés Peninsula, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the world's premier wildlife reserves. Here, vast colonies of sea elephants, whales and penguins far outnumber the few human visitors. Visit Tombo National Reserve, one of South America's largest breeding grounds for birds and mammals and experience the awe-inspiring sight of one of the world's largest Magellan penguin rookeries.

Feb 26: At Sea

Feb 27: Punta del Este, Uruguay

8:00 am - 4:00 pm

Punta del Este is often called the St. Tropez of Uruguay, known for its stunning beaches, luxurious resorts and trendy nightclubs. The vibrant atmosphere is further fueled by the glamorous Conrad Casino, offering a Vegas-style entertainment experience. Stroll along the elegant Calle Gorlero, where stylish boutiques and art galleries beckon, or unwind with a leisurely afternoon at a beachside café. Here, you can watch the world go by as sun seekers and jetsetters indulge in the laid-back luxury of one of the continent's most iconic playgrounds.

Feb 28 - March 1: Buenos Aires Return Flight to USA

Embark on a journey down the Tigre and Delta rivers, navigating a lush maze of waterways. Begin your adventure with a scenic drive through downtown Buenos Aires with views of the city's chic neighborhoods, including Vicente López, Martinez, Olivos and San Isidro y Acassuso. Visit San Isidro Cathedral and, if permitted, enjoy an interior visit. Then board your river boat for a cruise down the Tigre River. Leave the crowds behind and journey into a world that hasn't changed since the 1920s. Your day ends at the airport for an overnight flight home with unforgettable memories of your South America adventure.
